

2008 EXAM CYCLE SEMINAR INFORMATION

PREPARING TO PRACTICE BEFORE THE U.S. TAX COURT

LEARNING OBJECTIVES: The course is designed to assist tax professionals desiring to learn more about Tax Court practice and/or to prepare them to pass the written nonattorney admission exam administered biannually.

PROGRAM CONTENT: The Fields of Study include Taxes and Regulatory Ethics (see allocation by session below). The course presents material in the four subject areas tested, including Tax Court Practice and Procedure, Evidence, Legal Ethics and Federal Taxation. Prior Tax Court exam questions are used as the basis of material presented in the text and at live classes.

PROGRAM LEVEL: The course is presented as at an overview level: some Federal taxation topics presented are at an intermediate level and other topics are introduced at a basic level.

PROGRAM PREREQUISITES: The course is directed towards the tax professional with a basic foundation on individual Federal taxation topics. No specific education or experience is required for the other subject areas. Attendance is open to any tax professional.

DELIVERY METHOD: Group Live: see below for the 2008 Exam Cycle class schedule

RECOMMENDED CPE CREDITS: 64 (based upon a 50 minute hour) for the entire 2008 Exam Cycle live classes only (no CPE is available for the self-study option). See allocation by session below.

Session III • Review • 11/10-11/12/08, Alexandria, VA reviews all topics and includes a timed, practice test. Field of Study: Taxes (14 hours), Regulatory Ethics (2 hours). An informal study group is available to all registrants on Sunday 11/9/08.
